It is the responsibility of the adults in a child's life to protect the child. As one of the people you trust with your child, Dilley Beans Daycare provider(s) will do everything within their power to keep your child(ren) safe.

Every parent needs to know and understand that child care providers are mandatory reporters of suspected abuse and neglect. Not every bruise, cut, burn mark, etc. is a sign of abuse or neglect. But Oregon requires providers take required courses for observing child behaviors and conditions that may indicate abuse or neglect.

A care provider has no legal ability to deny access to a legal guardian, nor would Dilley Beans Daycare deny a parent access to their child at any time during child care. However, if abuse is suspected, a call to Child Protective Services will be made and they will determine the direction or closure of any investigation.

In the event a child is being picked up by someone believed to be under the influence of drugs (illegal or medication) or alcohol, the police will be called.

A report submitted to the Department of Human Services does not accuse anyone of abuse or neglect. A report states observations supporting the suspicion of abuse or neglect. Pertinent information and records are provided that would be helpful to the person investigating the report.

I agree that this form will remain in effect during the term of my child's enrollment. By signing below, I also agree that this is a legally binding form, and providing false information could be grounds for termination of childcare services, forfeiture of retainer, or both.
