

The following items are things that need to be at child care every day. They stay in your child(ren)'s cubby and are used as needed. A list will go home of items required for the next week of care, they need to come back the following week so they do not run out. Parents are required to check cubby for missing items and sizes of items regularly. Items that go home, need to come back the following day. Dilley Beans has back up items that can be used in an emergency but items like back up diapers may be associated with fees.

Infants (6 weeks to 1 year of age)

Clothing Items:

- Shirt/Pants
- Onesie – 2, at least 1 long sleeved
- Footed sleeper – long sleeved
- Socks – 2 pair
- Shoes – (toddling-walking) 1 pair, slip on or Velcro, hard bottoms

Diapering Items:

- Disposable Diapers - 2 packages required to start, will be relisted for replenishing when 2nd package opened
- For cloth diapered children 10 disposable diapers are required for back up, or 10 cloth diaper changes
- Disposable Diaper Wipes (3 packages required to start, will be relisted for replenishing when 3rd package opened)
 - Brands of wipes allowed include 7th generation, Babyganics, Earth's Best, and any wipes with a 3 or lower rating by www.ewg.org.
- Diaper Cream – One of each acceptable cream, in a new, unopened container
 - Creams can include coconut oil, bag balm, Babyganics, 7th Generation, Earth Baby, Bordeaux butt paste, and any cream with a 3 or lower rating by www.ewg.org.
 - No baby powder will be used.

Feeding Items:

- 2 Big Bibs – For meal time
- 2 Small Bibs – Needed while babies are teething or if baby often drools
- For Breastmilk fed babies – provide milk fresh daily as able and as much frozen milk as possible (up to one week's worth)
 - If the amount of frozen milk becomes more than 1 week's supply, it will be returned to parents at pick up for use/storage at home)
- For Formula fed babies – provide 2 unopened cans of aged appropriate formula. Formula must be the same used at home, or a doctor's note is required to be on file at child care. (This will be listed for replenishing when the 2nd can is opened.)
- For babies fed both breastmilk and formula – Enough of both options should be provided to child care with instructions as to when each is to be used. Up to 1 week's supply of frozen breastmilk can be stored. At least one, no more than two, cans of infant formula should be provided.
- (0-12 months) - 2 complete bottles. Preferably two different types/speeds of flow so that baby has options.
- (10 months-24 months) – 2 complete sippy cups. Preferably two different types so that toddler has options.
- Toothbrush – for infants with 1 or more teeth

Other Optional Items:

- 2-3 Pacifiers (0-crawling) – optional for infants that use pacifiers. No pacifiers for children once they start walking.
- Gas Drops
- Topical teething ointment

Toddlers (1 year to potty trained)

Clothing Items:

- Shirt/Pants
- Onesie – 2, at least 1 long sleeved (optional)
- Socks – 2 pair
- Shoes – 1 pair, slip on or Velcro, hard bottoms

Diapering Items:

- Disposable Diapers - 2 packages required to start, will be relisted for replenishing when 2nd package opened
- For cloth diapered children 10 disposable diapers are required for back up, or 10 cloth diaper changes
- Disposable Diaper Wipes (3 packages required to start, will be relisted for replenishing when 3rd package opened)
 - Brands of wipes allowed include 7th generation, Babyganics, Earth's Best, and any wipes with a 3 or lower rating by www.ewg.org.
- Diaper Cream – One of each acceptable cream, in a new, unopened container
 - Creams can include coconut oil, bag balm, Babyganics, 7th Generation, Earth Baby,

Bordeaux butt paste, and any cream with a 3 or lower rating by www.ewg.org.

- No baby powder will be used.

Feeding Items:

- 2 Big Bibs – For meal time
- Breastmilk and/or Formula - If still using either, see above instructions.
- (10 months-24 months) – 2 complete sippy cups. Preferably two different types so that toddler has options.
- Toothbrush – for toddlers with 1 or more teeth

Naptime comfort item

- Each child may have up to one personal blanket and one stuffed animal / doll for naptime.

Other Optional Items:

- Gas Drops
- Topical teething ointment

PreSchool and Over (potty trained until Kindergarden)

Clothing Items:

- Shirt/Pants
- Socks – 2 pair
- Shoes – 1 pair, hard bottoms, laces ok if child can tie own shoes.

Diapering Items:

- For potty trained children under the age of 3 ½, 10 disposable diapers / trainers are required for back up

Feeding Items:

- Toothbrush

Naptime comfort item

- Each child may have up to one personal blanket and one stuffed animal / doll for naptime.

Kindergarden and Before/After School

Clothing Items:

- Shirt/Pants
- Socks – 2 pair
- Shoes – 1 pair, hard bottoms, laces ok if child can tie own shoes.

Feeding Items:

- Toothbrush
