According to Oregon Department of Education Early Learning Division, 205, Registered Family Child Care Homes Code 414-205-0100

(9) Sunscreen is considered a non-prescription medication and may be used for child care children under the following conditions:

- (a) Providers must obtain written parental authorization prior to using sunscreen.
- (b) One container of sunscreen may be used for child care children unless a parent supplies an individual container for their child. The sunscreen shall be applied in a manner that prevents contaminating the container.
- (c) Parents must be informed of the type of product and the sun protective factor (SPF).
- (d) Parents must be given the opportunity to inspect the product and active ingredients.
- (e) If sunscreen is supplied for an individual child care child, the sunscreen must be labeled with the child's first and last name and must be used for only that child.
- (f) Providers must reapply sunscreen every two hours while the child care children are exposed to the sun.
- (g) Providers shall use a sunscreen with an SPF of 15 or higher and must be labeled as "Broad Spectrum".
- (h) Providers shall not use aerosol sunscreens on child care children.
- (i) Sunscreen shall not be used on child care children younger than six months.
- (j) Child care children over six years of age may apply sunscreen to themselves under the direct supervision of the provider or staff member.

This rule is applied for all topicals. Brand and topical specifics are subject to change, parents will be provided information before usage and can modify this agreement at any time.

I understand that it is my responsibility to update this form in the event that I no longer wish to authorize one or more of the above uses. I agree that this form will remain in effect during the term of my child's enrollment. By signing below, I also agree that this is a legally binding form, and providing false information could be grounds for termination of childcare services, forfeiture of retainer, or both.
